

MBA Scholarships

To cover full tuition fees

Newcastle University Business School offers three full fee MBA scholarship awards to assist high calibre MBA students with good qualifications to study for an MBA degree. The awards will be credited to the student's fee account.

Awards include:

- MBA Sustainable Leadership Scholarship
- MBA Responsible Impact Scholarship
- MBA Advancing Women in Leadership Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

1. An applicant can only apply and be considered for a full fee MBA scholarship after they have been offered a place to study on the Full-time MBA programme at the University's Newcastle city centre campus for the 2025/26 academic year beginning in September 2025.
2. To be considered for the MBA Advancing Women in Leadership Scholarship applicants must identify as female. This criterion **does not** apply to the MBA Sustainable Leadership Scholarship or the MBA Responsible Impact Scholarship.
3. The closing date for applications will be 20th April 2025. Awards will be based on fully completed applications received by the date. Unsuccessful applicants will not be considered for awards at later application points.

If no successful candidates are awarded by 20th April 2025, by the Scholarship Committee, the application deadline may be extended to 9th May 2025. Please check the Business School scholarships pages for updates

4. Successful applicants will be selected on merit; interview performance, essay response, and allocation of scholarships will be based on the Business School's priorities which may alter from time to time. 5. To receive awards applicants must become registered students at Newcastle University in the 2025-26 academic year for the Full-time MBA programme. Awards cannot be deferred to later academic years.
6. Scholarship awards will cover the full cost of tuition fees.
7. Fully sponsored students do not qualify for these awards. This includes any students with alternative full fee scholarships or full sponsorship that covers tuition fees and maintenance costs. The University reserves the right to suspend payment and recover any scholarship amounts already made to students with full funding.

8. Scholarships will not be confirmed unless applicants satisfy all conditions related to their admissions offer.
9. Applicants may apply for and/or be considered for more than one scholarship or award but if successful in any of the full fee awards, they will not also receive any other MBA or University managed Scholarship. They will receive this higher award with the lower value award reallocated to another applicant.
10. Awardees will commit to supporting some marketing activities to support Newcastle University Business School's recruitment and marketing campaigns, this may include sharing and highlighting their experiences on the programme and at the school.
11. These scholarships are for new students entering the full-time MBA programme in September 2025. Current students registered at the University who have already commenced their postgraduate degree are not eligible. Awards cannot be made retrospectively.
12. The Business School reserves the right to vary all or any scholarship awards at its sole discretion.
13. The Business School's decision on all MBA Scholarship awards and interpretation of rules and regulations shall be final: appeals will not be considered.
