An Introductory explanation

Introduction: The Collection has two catalogues:-

- MTSC Catalogue 1 Archival Materials of our unique unpublished materials (an Excel spreadsheet), mostly unique company records, with about 20,000 entries.
- <u>MTSC Catalogue 2 Published Materials</u> *you are reading it now!* but only the introductory page (a Word doc) explaining the catalogue (an Excel Spreadsheet). Mostly technical publications e.g. books, periodicals, ship registers, etc.

Material titles & abbreviations: The Collection uses non-standard abbreviations for many periodicals (magazines/journals) titles, organisation names, etc.

Key to column headings in the table below:

- <u>Material type</u>: The Collections uses its own broad classifications: Audio-visual materials, Books (mostly textbooks subdivided by subjects such as Marine Engineering, or specific types Bibliographies, Biographies, Dictionaries, Directories (non-governmental unofficial)), Companies (mostly unique company records), Maps & Almanacs, Miscellaneous, Periodicals (mostly trade & industry magazines, & research journals), Photographs, Rules & Regulations, Ship Registers (governmental official registers), Statistical & Marketing Reports.
- Materials. Holdings. Contents:
 - Materials: Author, title, publisher, etc.
 - o Holdings: Parts held in the Collection. Where cataloguing is incomplete they are as listed as "Cataloguing in progress".
 - o Contents: about the scope of the material.
- Location Storage Unit No. & S/D: Storage Units and Rooms where materials are located. Numbered < X.nnn.z > where:
 - o S/D is the Shelf or Drawer within each Unit. Cupboards & Shelving Units have shelves. Filing Cabinets & Plan Chests have drawers.
 - o X is the Unit Type: C = Cupboard. F = Filing Cabinet. P = Plan Chest. S = Shelving.
 - o nnn is the Unit Number: There are two rooms Lower and Upper. 100 to 199 = Units in Lower Room. 200 to 299 = Units in Upper Room.

 \circ <u>z</u> is the shelf or drawer number. "1" is the lowest shelf or drawer within each unit. E.g.

C.101.1 = Cupboard 101 in Lower Room 1, shelf no.1. F.106.4 = Filing Cabinet 106 in Lower Room 1, drawer no.4. P.204.3 = Plan Chest 204. in Upper Room 2, drawer no.3. S.219.2 = Shelving Unit 219 in Upper Room 2, shelf no.2.

NOTE. All locations and storage unit numbers will change during Autumn 2024 when the Collection in transferred from the on-campus Armstrong Building to Newcastle Robinson Library "Research Reserve" at Team Valley off-campus. MTSC Cat 1 & Cat 2 will then be updated to show these new locations.

All materials will eventually be listed on the Robinson Library Catalogue – this may take several years.

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<u>Appendix 1: Storage Units numbering</u>. The Collection renumbered all units during 2020 but this was not fully completed due to COVID and the death of our colleague Brian Newman. Some units may retain their original Unit Number within the Collection's <u>Catalogue</u> of unique company materials.

- Original numbering: L = Lower Room. U = Upper Room. E.g. L8 = Lower Room, Shelf Unit 8. U23 = Upper Room, Shelf Unit 23. E.g. FC224 = Filing Cabinet 224 in Upper Room. Shelves with each unit numbered L8/1, /2 etc. or drawers in each unit FC224/1 /2 etc.
- Numbers are mostly very similar e.g. U21/1 > S.221.1, FC224/2 > F.224.2, L2/6 > S.102.6 . See table below. Please ask for advice if necessary.
