	was to establish a clear framework in line with Statute 52(2) for Senate to
	monitor and assess significant changes to the academic character, and mission
	of the university, ensuring Senate's active role in making representations to
	Council prior to any redundancies. Senate resolved to agree the
	recommendation to schedule an extraordinary meeting of Senate to receive
	and review any business plan for redundancies, at a time that information
	could be shared, as law and confidentiality allows. Senate resolved to agree
	that Executive Board would provide a schedule of information and reports
	for ensuring Senators were informed in relation to significant changes to
	education and research where academic oversight and expertise was
	required.
