Dates to keep in mind:

- **Details of your Peer Mentor:** by 2nd September – you'll be sent an email with a letter from your Peer Mentor with their contact details
- **Personal tutor allocation:** by 27th September – we can't allocate personal tutors until you've chosen your modules, so CH students find out the details of their personal tutors a little later than other students. Check your email for communication from them about first meeting
- **Module amendment deadline:** by 4th October – you're able to submit a Module Amendment form until the end of teaching week 2 each semester, so if you find you're not getting on with a module you can request to change this. If the module is compulsory then it can't be changed, if you want to change subjects get in touch with your DPD for Stage 1 (Franck Michel). You must check the timetable for clashes between lectures before submitting the request.
