Dates to keep in mind:

- Details of your Peer Mentor: by 2nd September you'll be sent an email with a letter from your Peer Mentor with their contact details
- **Personal tutor allocation:** by 27th September we can't allocate personal tutors until you've chosen your modules, so CH students find out the details of their personal tutors a little later than other students. Check your email for communication from them about first meeting
