SCOPE OF APPLICATIONS

The MSc Physician Associate Studies is a medical non-modular professional degree programme therefore it is not possible to accept Recognition of Prior Learning, Recognition of Experiential Learning or Credit Transfer.

Similarly, due to the differences in curriculum delivery, applications to transfer from other similar programmes will not normally be considered unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Internal Credit Transfer

Previous students who graduated with a PGDip can apply to top up to Master's level. This will be available to PGDip in Physician Associate Studies Newcastle graduates only and for academic year 2023 – 2024 and 2024 – 2025.
