RPL and credit transfer is available for all modules to a maximum of 60 credits.

Normally only learning within the last 5 years can be taken into account.

For a) and b) above – transcript showing level, module credits, and marks plus copies of syllabuses.

For (c) - dates and details of relevant experience with evidence (e.g. employer statement, publications, or accreditation etc.) and an explanation as to how the learning outcomes of the modules for which the applicant seeks RPL have been met.

WHAT ADVICE AND INFORMATION WILL BE GIVEN

Each applicant for RPL or credit transfer will be issued with the relevant module outline forms specifying learning outcomes and given an RPL/credit transfer application form.

Advice will be available from the Education Administrator.

HOW RPL/CREDIT TRANSFER DECISIONS ARE MADE

Applications should be submitted via email and will be considered by the DPD. Applicants should hear the results of their application within 20 working days.
